Establishment and Inauguration (1962):

Ramakrishna Mission Secondary School in Ladmawphlang was established in 1962, through the initiative of the Durbar Shnong and with the full support of the Ramakrishna Mission Ashrama Sohra. The school's held that bv inauguration, graced Swami same year, was Sudhabuddhananda, the then-secretary of the Ramakrishna Mission Ashrama, Sohra, alongside representatives from the mission, the School Managing Committee (SMC), and the sirdar of the time, (L) Tran Kharnaior, with his executive committee. (L) Net Tyrong, the headmaster at the time, and one assistant teacher were also present. This event marked the beginning of the school's mission to provide quality education to the local community, a mission that has been continuously supported and reinforced by the Ramakrishna Mission. Although the school started with a small number of students, the steady support from the mission and the local community has enabled it to grow over the years.
