History of the Ramakrishna Mission School, Laitkroh

Our School was established in the year 1964. In the beginning year the school was running in the house of (L) Mrs. Brel Dohling and later on it had shifted to the house of (L) Iret Kharkongor who was at that time the Sirdar of Elaka Laitkroh. The present plot of land in which the school was situated now was also donated by him I.e (L) Iret Kharkongor. (L) Mr. Iret Kharkongor (the then Sirdar of Elaka Laitkroh) and the members of the village together with Secretary form the Ramakrishna Mission Ashrama Sohra joined hand together and started to build this school in this plot of land.

The School was inaugurated by the Secretary from Ramakrishna Mission Sohra and (L) Mr. Jret Kharkongor along with the members of the village in the year 1970, (L) Mrs Valley Was was the Head Teacher at that time and the assistant teacher are (L) Newly Umdor and (L) Midolis Hynniewta. After (L) Mrs Valley War left the school (L) Smor Nongkynrih was selected as the Head teacher in this school. Mrs. Thirty Kharkongor but now was the retired Head teacher in the year 2019 was the assistant teacher at that time.

Since 1964 - 2021, the condition of the school was very poor with three classrooms and one small staff room. It was built with cement, wood and tin roof only. Later on at the beginning of the year 2022. Our Secretary Maharaj Anuragananda, started to built a new school which was completed in a very short time in the month of May 2022 and now we have got seven classrooms for the students and one room for the teachers. So we the teachers are very happy to get a new school in place of the old one.

The school aim at providing a good education to the students and to develop their complete personality. The school also take great initiative between teachers and the students.

The presence of the school help the poor students in the village. All the students get free uniforms, books, school bags, etc. Every year the mission from Sohra distributed rice and dal to the students.

Different events organised in the school to motivate the students and to help them to develop their creative skills in different activities. The students can take part in the English and Khasi recitation competition to encourage the student to develop in speaking skills.

Patriotic Song competition, the main purpose for conducting this competition was to develop feeling of patriotism among the students. Drawing competition to create interest among the students in colours and drawing skills. Solo Dance and Group Dance to promote daily physical fitness and personal confidence among the students. Annual Sport day was conducted every year. All the students actively participate in the Marchpass, Running, Stappoo, Snatch the Hanky, 3 legged Race, Collecting Stones, Mawpoin, Chess and Khokho was also displayed.

Play Day for U Soso Tham Day also was conducted every year with free hand exercise, Martial Arts, Animal Post, Khasi Dance and Hindi Folk Song at Sohra playground that was participated by all the LPs Students of all RKM Schools.

Participation events, Seminars, Conference, etc, for the teachers was also conducted at Sohra. All the teachers actively participated in all the workshops and orientations in different subjects conducted by the Mission to broader the knowledge and new teaching skills for the teachers.
