RAMAKRISHNA MISSION LP SCHOOL, LUMLANGDOH West Jaintia Hills District



Lumlangdoh is a locality under Nongjngi Village, its falls under Thadlaskein Block, West Jaintia Hills District, Meghalaya, with a total population of 378, where most residents are farmers. Due to the limited educational resources, with only one government lower primary (L.P.) school and a single teacher, many children in the village lacked access to education, as their parents could not afford to send them to distance schools.

In response to this issue, the village headman and secretary visited the Rama Krishna Mission in Sohra, West Khasi Hills District, in 2022 to discuss the village's educational challenges. They requested assistance in establishing a school in Lumlangdoh. In November 2022, Maharaj, the Secretary of the Rama Krishna Mission, along with Shri Ram Samati (Headman), Shri Lastborn Samati (Secretary), Shri Kiton Samati (Ex-MDC), and Shri Manbha Lyngdoh (RKM teacher),

visited Lumlangdoh to assess the situation. After discussions with the villagers, they agreed to use the community hall as a temporary school while a permanent building will started construct.

On March 6, 2023, the school opened with classes from Nursery to Class I, enrolling 56 students and employing three teachers. By 2024, the school had expanded to include classes up to Class II, with a total enrollment of 79 students and four teachers. The school has made significant progress, and the community hopes it will continue to grow, providing quality education to ensure a bright future of the young children's.
