RKM LP SCHOOL, MARAIKAPHON

Ramakrishna Mission L.P School Maraikaphon, Sohra (Cherrapunjee) was started in 1931 by Revered Swami Prabhanandaji popularly known as Ketaki Maharaj.

Previously the School was called 'Ka Seng Babha School'. It was started by a group of local people to educate the local children since there was no school in the area at that time. When Ketaki Maharaj came to Sohra for philanthropic activities, the local people handed over the School to him as they were not able to run the school any longer. At that time the School was run in a rented house and (L) Babu Mobin Roy Kharkongor was the teacher.

Some important people who had help Our R K M Maraikaphon school to come into being were: Babu Mobin Roy Kharkongor, Kong Niwer Swer, Bah Klur Nongkynrih, Bah Eljo Kishore Nongkynrih, Kong Nesidora Diengdoh and Bah Narad Hynniewta

Some local lady from Khliehshnong, Kong Niwer Swer bought a plot of land and gifted to R K Mission to construct an LP School there.

(L) Kong Nesidora Diengdoh was the first Head Teacher of the newly constructed school. The second HT was (L) Kong Getcicil Chyne followed by Kong Diacyna Kharkongor, Kong Jermon Nongbri and now Kong Gitabali Majaw.
