History of the Ramakrishna Mission Secondary School, Mawmluh



RKM SECONDARY SCHOOL, MAWMLUH

The School was established in 1959 with LP Section and it started functioning from 1960. The Classes were taken in the morning. At that time Late Smt. N D Roy was the Asstt. Teacher of Ramakrishna Mission Higher Secondary School, Sohra (Cherrapunjee). She used to attend School at Sohra (Cherrapunjee) during the day time but in the morning she taught in Ramakrishna Mission LP School, Mawmluh. She was the founder Head Teacher of Ramakrishna Mission LP School, Mawmluh. The LP Section got its permission from the government in 1968 the Office its recognition in 2002. Her husband Late Babu D.N.Roy was also the Asstt. Teacher of Ramakrishna Mission Higher Secondary School, Sohra (Cherrapunjee). He

retired from Higher Secondary School, Sohra (Cherrapunjee) in 1968 but Late Smt. N.D.Roy in 1984. After five years of his retirement i.e. in 1973, there was opened the M.E.School, Mawmluh. Both the wife and the husband were the first and founder Head Teacher and Headmaster of LP and ME Section respectively. The LP Section i.e in the morning and ME Section in the day as it is today. The ME or UP Section was recognized in 1997.

Late Smt. N.D.Roy, was cordially called Kong Nesido and Late Babu D.N.Roy, was cordially called Babu Diion. The full name of Late. Smt. N.D.Roy was Late Smt. Nesido Diengdoh Roy and Late Babu D.N.Roy was Late Shri. Diion Nongkynrih Roy.

Late Smt. N.D. Roy, who was the Head Teacher of our LP Section and the Asstt. Teacher of R.K.Mission H S School, Sohra (Cherrapunjee) retired from R.K.Mission H S School, Sohra (Cherrapunjee) in 1984. After her retirement she remained only as the Head Teacher of Ramakrishna Mission LP School, Mawmluh till 1995 at the age of 71. But Late Babu D.N.Roy who retired in 1968 from Sohra (Cherrapunjee) School was the Headmaster of R.K. Mission ME School, Mawmluh from 1973 to 1975 at the age of 67 years.

Late Babu D.N.Roy died on 15.04.1992 at the ripe age of 84 and Late Smt. N.D.Roy died on 25.12.2005 at the ripe age of 81. They were cordially remembered by the Ramakrishna Mission Ashrama, Sohra (Cherrapunjee) in the Managing Committee Meeting and in the Re-union of the Ex-students of

Ramakrishna Mission H S School, Sohra (Cherrapunjee) as seen in the Souvenir by the present Headmaster of Secondary Section.

The Head Teacher of LP Section who was after Late N.D.Roy was Smt. D.B.Wankhar in February, 1995. There comes Smt. Iadalincy Dkhar in 2015 as the new Head Teacher created by the retirement of Smt. D.B.Wankhar on 08.12.2014. Smt. Iadalincy Dkhar, Head Teacher retired on 26th July 2024 and the Secretary, Ramakrishna Mission Ashrama, Sohra selected Smt. Euginia Khongtim, Asst. Teacher of LP Section to be the Head Teacher of LP Section in place of Smt. Iadalincy Dkhar from 27th July 2024.

The Headmaster/Headmistress of ME/UP Section after Late Babu D.N.Roy was Smt. S.I.Tariang in February, 1976. After her voluntarily retirement in 1995, there came Smt. D.Dohling till she retired on 01.03.2012. After her retirement Shri W. Bracket Sing Swer took charge as the Headmaster of this ME/UP Section till date.

In 1997, the ME Section which comprised from class IV to class VI up to 1996, was upgraded as UP Section which comprised from class V to class VII.

In 2003, the UP Section was upgraded to Secondary Section with Class VIII and Smt. D.Dohling was the founder Headmistress of Ramakrishna Mission Secondary School, Mawmluh. She was the Headmistress of this Section till 14.11.2010. On 15.11.2010, Shri. W. Bracket Sing Swer, Asstt. Teacher of UP Section took charge as the Headmaster of Ramakrishna Mission Secondary School, Mawmluh by virtue of graduation and teachers' Training, till date.

The Secondary Section got its Opening Permission in 2012 vide Order No. DSEL/SEC-NG/OP/8/2010/-89 Dated: Shillong, the 4th September 2012 from the Director of School Education and Literacy, Meghalaya, Shillong & Chairman, State Level Regional Committee for Opening Permission of Secondary & Higher Secondary Schools.

The Regular Opening Permission our School got in 2017 vide Order No. DSEL/SEC-NG/OP//2/2013/Pt. II Dated: Shillong, the 22nd December 2017 from the Director of School Education and Literacy, Meghalaya, Shillong.

The School got its Affiliation from Meghalaya Board of School Education, Shillong/Tura in 2022 with the Affiliation No. 10701.

The area of the land given to the School as long as it was the LP and UP Section was 368 Sq.m but it is a matter of great joy that the land given by the Mawmluh Village Durbar is 4320 Sq.m as soon as it was opened as Secondary Section.

The land was given by the Mawmluh Village Durbar. The building grant of LP & UP Section was sanctioned by the Secretary, Ramakrishna Mission Ashrama, Sohra (Cherrapunjee). In 2003, when Secondary Section was opened there was no building. In 2006, new building was started for Secondary Section with the fund raised from the 150th Birth Anniversary of Ma Sarada Devi. The School was very much thankful to Srimat Swami Sumedhanandaji Maharaj, Secretary, Ramakrishna Mission Ashrama, Sohra for the procurement of this new building.

The School as a whole is very much thankful to Swami Anuragananda, Respected Secretary, Ramakrishna Mission Ashrama, Sohra for his tireless efforts to extend the existing building both in the ground floor and first floor so as to ease the congestion in the class rooms. It is due to him that the School got its fencing for the security of the School.

Moreover, Respected Swami Anuragananda had done his utmost to provide computers to the School for further learning of the Students under MPLADS courtesy by Hon'ble MP Prof. Mrinal Miri @ Rs. 5.00 Lakhs. He also arranged the room for Library and Science Laboratory.

The School is much indebted to Swami Anuragananda that due to his efforts the School got its Affiliation with MBOSE in the year 2022.

The geographical area of the School is that the School is located at an altitude of 1247m from the sea level. The GPS Coordinate of the School is 25° 25 Latitude and 91° 70 Longitude.

The School as it is now is due to the tireless efforts of the Mawmluh Village Durbar for extending its help to donate the land and to initiate meaningful action in proceeding it from UP Section to Secondary Section in 2003. Moreover, the Ramakrishna Mission Ashrama, Sohra (Cherrapunjee) also had tried its utmost to run this School to the best effect. The credit goes to the Ramakrishna Mission Ashrama, Sohra (Cherrapunjee) and especially to the Mawmluh Village Durbar. The School remains thankful also to Shri. P.S. Lyngdoh, Sirdar of Mawmluh Village Durbar, who is also the President, Managing Committee, Ramakrishna Mission Secondary School, Mawmluh

that under his leadership he was able to upgrade the School to Secondary Section as it is now.
