The Ramakrishna Mission Lower Primary and Middle English School Mawshamok was started from a small beginning. It was established in the year 1960, offer mutual understanding between the R.K.M with the inhabitants of Mawshamok village. It was first situated in the upper part of the village. constructed with bamboos and thatch roof.

On reaching the agreement with the family of Rev. Sabiral Marbaniang, the school was then shifted to the plot of land donated by the above mention family at Krem Mawshamok in the year 1967.

Under the dynamic leadership of (L) shri Hadwel Wanwar, as its first President of the school managing committee, Inhabitants of the area, contributed a lot, like man-power and even some gifts to teachers at the initial stage.

The LP School, started at 7:00 AM and closes at 10:00 A.M while M.E Section would start from 10:00 AM up to 3:00P.M.

Due to the untiring, selfless and hard works of its first teaching staff, (L) Rusten Majaw and (L) smt Throstimal Majaw and the local people collectively. The school was upgraded to M.E school section just within the following year in 1961, with three teachers. (L) Wasten Majaw (Headmaster) and (L) shri Hopingford Sawian and (L) Korestorwel Majaw as Assistant teacher.

As years passed by the enrolment of the students was increasing more and more than expected. But the problems arose as teachers were leaving the school one by one. One could not deny the fact that it was due to call of (L) Swami Gogulanandigi that the ex-student of R.K.M H/S School Sohra, Shri Fulistarwel Majaw and Densil Bngem did come to serve the school from the years 1973-1974. The latter left the school in the year 1985 which resulted in closing down of the M.E School Section.

Then after a gap of 36years that the M.E Section (Upper Primary Section) was re-open with Smt RILANG MARBANIANG as the Headmistress with 5/6 Assistant teacher both in L.P and U.P Section, in the year 2022

Some of its past students worth mentioning and working in deferent spheres, as good citizents are Mr D.Danial Khylllep Assistant Director Border Area Department government of Meghalaya, Dr Hesemaiah langrai the then Vice-Principal of Shillong collage and many others.

Today the Ramakrishna Mission, Sohra being the sponsoring body makes all its efforts to run and raise to standard of the school relying on the shoulders of the present qualified teaching staff.

Hope that the school would gain its popularity in years to come.
