## Ramakrishna Mission LP/UP / SEC School: Nartiang Dist: East Khasi Hills: Meghalaya



## **RKM SECONDARY SCHOOL, NARTIANG**

The school was established by Ramakrishna Mission Ashram, Cherrapunjee round in 1967-1968 with very few Pre-Primary students and two teachers hailing from Sheila deputed 1 Gent and 1 Lady directed from R.K. Mission Ashrama, Cherrapunjee. The school functioned within small bamboo hut at Pohpalat locality, but unfortunately within a very short period both the teachers were discontinued.

Then the school was shifted to the resident of Shri (L) Ridonket, the person who was instrument in starting it. During this period the Mission gave the appointment from the local teachers as

- 1. Shri lang Ryngkhlem from Jowai in 1968
- 2. Shri (L) Salong Myria from Nartiang during 1968-1971
- 3. Smti (L) Bihthai Symblai in the year 1972
- 4. Smti Mithilda Siangshai from 1972.

In the year 1975, the school was shifted to the present premises, the land which was donated by Shri (L) Dontha Dkhar. Here the Mission was urther appointed Shri (L) Stay fast Tynnaw of Sohbarpunjee as the Head Teacher where as Shri lang Ryngkhlem has left the school in 1974 and also Smti Songbih Myria was appointed as Assistant Teacher in 1976 by Swami Gokulananda, Secretary R.K. Mission Ashram, Cherrapunjee.

With his holiness, special devotion to the people of Nartiang, so in the year 1977 the school was upgraded to ME standard with four brilliant students named - (1) Shri (L) Sa long Nongtdeh (2) Smti Joycy Nongpluh (3) Smti Tro Ktung (4) Smti Plinda Lyrnai. The first headmaster of M.E. Section was Shri (L) Denis Dkhar from Mukroh Village from 1977 - 1979. After him, Shri Don Dhar substituted for a short period and from 1981 - 1990 Shri Moina Singh Phyllut served as the Headmaster with two assistant teachers named - (1) Smti Joycy Nongpluh and Smti Dial Phawa. During this period the procession was held in Nartiang

on account of the Birth Day Celebration of Sri Ramakrishna. Then Shri Moina Singh Phyllut left and Shri (L) Chandra Has Sinha was appointed as the Headmaster of M.E. Section.

In the year 1997 the school was upgraded to Secondary Section and temporary allowed Shri (L) Chandra Has Sinha to incharge the Secondary Section till Shri Satios Bhoi S/o Shri (Late) Dontha Dkhar, School's Land Donor, became the headmaster of Secondary School till now.

## Some of the important alumni of the school are:-

- 1. **Mr. Donbok Buam**: He passed his s.s.L.e. Exam from this school in 1<sup>st</sup> Division with two distinctions. Later, he completed his engineering course and now working as an engineer in a private farm.

- 4. Miss Glorisa Nongpluh

## The famous person in this locality are -

(1) Shri Moina Singh Phyllut and (2) Shri Don Dhar

Nartiang Elaka is famous for cultivation of red rice. Kamala fruit is less when compare to other areas and no quarrying of limestone is practised in this area. Nartiang Village is also considered as a holy place because of the existence of Durga Temple, Shiva Temple and Bishori Temple. It is also famous for monoliths or stones garden.
