RKM UP SCHOOL, RUDU-B

A mini History of Rudu-B LP School run by the Ramakrishna Mission Ashrama, Cherrapunjee, East Khasi Hills District, Meghalaya. It is almost eighteen years back since the records begin to crawl with the ray of light of shining for founding a school in the heart of Rudu-B.

In due course, a dream came to Shri. Mohanto Hajong that was followed by Shri Bishnu Hajong. Both of them held a talk to a dear one to Shri Novokumar Hajong, Shri Prabin Hajong also from Panchiring is shared to it. On hearing this talk, Shri Brahmanau Hajong hurriedly supported it and so did he. The entry grew stronger, now the four heads exercised to play the games. A goal for building an institution at Rudu-B went on in full swing. Therefore, a meeting was convinced by Shri Mohanto Hajong to be held at the home-yard to Mrs. Novokumar Hajong. The meeting was graced with 109 populations out of 25 households responded to it. This was the higher calling of the heads. It was February the end, 1998, a managing committee was formed by consisting of seven members. In this respect, Shri Late Prabin Hajong was elected as the President while Shri Mohanto Hajong as the Secretary of the committee. Members of the committee includes Shri Novokumar Hajong, Shri Jonggeram Hajong, Shri Akonto Hajong, Shri Bishnu Hajong, Shri Nikhili Hajong, Shri Premananda Hajong. Shri Brahmanan Hajong was elected as the Vice-President as well. Therefore, they committed to a firm determination for working out to the words. In the meantime, Shri Novokumar Hajong had a commitment for donating a land property for the foundation of a school building.

The local thought hard for the crying need of the school to educate their children. So, Shri Novokumar Hajong, with all his might stood by them. In the long run, Shri Mohanto Hajong was appointed as the Headmaster of the school. A sum of Rupees Five Hundred only per month at fixed for the Headmaster. So, as on the circumstances, a funding was treasured by generous donation to meet the requirements. By turn, the school was built with its roofing in thatch, the sitting capacity made out of bamboos. Neither the furniture nor any materials were there in the school. Admission on starting register was 35 students in number. By degrees, Shri Arjun Koch came forward and was the first assistant teacher next to Mohanto Hajong. Hereafter, Shri Mithun Hajong from Balat, Shri Bairisthya Hajong and Miss Gharua Hajong joined the staff.

In the year 1999, student's enrolment multiplied and co-mutual cooperations amongst the teachers, guardians including the members strengthened. It reminds that Shri Premananda Hajong from Karaigora village who stayed in Cherrapunjee, serving for years did his all possible help for the institution. Furnitures like chairs, tables blackboards furnished with suitable accommodating raised up in room.

In 2001, arrangement was made for on an invitation to the honour of Swami Nityamuktananda for his kind visit to the school.

The President and the Secretary had their communication round the clock to the higher authority of the Ashrama.

In the nick of time, he came on a visit to the school. So, the people welcomed the monk's guest in a befitting manner. He was pleased with the arrangement. He looked into the matter to the bottom of the heart. He kept in records. As such, the monk's heart. Seeing the people in wants melted out. In his speech he gave a word of action.

In few days, he sent out books and uniforms before long and great deal of varied items. Swami Nityamuktananda brought about a great of fortune for a school building at Rudu-B. He suggested the teachers to live a simple life but high thinking throughout their life. Besides, he wanted changing for the life-style of the teachers as a whole. He pacified the staff with a loving tunes. But all on the sudden, it was heard verbally that calling for leaving to Andaman happened to him. It is an Island territory to the south of across the sea. In this juncture, there was a death shock from Panchiring 'B' that Shri Probin is no more.

A problem aroused in the committee. In this regard, a talk held on about the President in his place. In the same way, Shri Brahman Hajong was selected as the President while Shri Rai Mohon Hajong, Shri Dhrepen

Hajong nad Shri Prabin Hajong were the members. According to the situation of the institution, the managing committee remembered Miss Nirnaya Hajong and was installed as the Head in place of Shri Mohanto Hajong. He handed over the charge to Miss Nirnaya through a sound mood.

A new institution made the villagers changing. They got encouragement among themselves. A change took place like the leaves shed out old ones for covering the trees with green in full. It mentioned that the beginning as on the arrival of the Swamijis, people from all walks of life came in swarms with their hubs, clapping in joy and through the school compound for welcoming the monks guest and participated in the ceremonial function. Singing hymns inn chorus by playing on musical instruments filled the air with a beyond cheers.

Afterwards, khichuri dish served out to the strangers. They fed from their hearts. Fortunes played out good smile every lips. The systematic habitual have been running for years together. At length, the previous teachers, in any way, had a good staff on affairs of schooling. But for the sake of needs. Several of the staff stooped from service.

Rudu-B and the surrounding blessed a lot by the Shree Ramakrishna Thakur and Maa Sarada Devi and also by Swami Vivekananda. Furthermore, a great contribution of the swamiji's from the monastic shrine of Cherrapunjee, East Khasi Hills District.

To note that the establishment now stands with a proud looks that faces towards the scenic beauty on the north. The local people here will be thankful for centuries and shall remain indebted to the organization. This was concluded by taking an oath that "Good we learn, bad we shun. This is the goal for education."

Shri Mohanto Hajong tried the best, he communicated with Mission Authority in black and white. He headed the committee on the right way and played a good role for the sake of the institution. So, he was the instrument in starting it no doubt.

Local donors and buildings grants at the time of inception:

Shri Novokumar Hajong is the local driver. Besides this, he is one of the persons giving others encouragement. He comes next to Mohanto Hajong.

Some of the important Alumni of the school:

Shri Martin Danggo, the local MLA is the famous person form our locality. He has been looking after people under his constituency. He stands by the common people in all respect. Any other information for discussion:

The Rudu-B is located among other villages bordering on Bangladesh, so, there are seven villages of Hajong's. They are altogether called Saatgaon. Nevertheless, the Garos are the majority here among the regional inhabitants in the extreme territorial's border. Most of the people here are landless and poor. They earn by hard labour and live from hands to mouth. A total population is eight to nine thousand approximately. A very few keep shops and farm the land. Several others are doing jobs either teachers or various Government and NGO services. In relation to the religion that most of them are Christian and the remaining are Hinduism.

The parents meeting holds before opening the school session once a year. Social works are being done by the parents as and when needed. The students here are very competitive. They used to participate in any forms of events conducted by the Block level and got many prizes. Student's profile of R.K. Mission LP School Rudu-B: 40% above had successfully passed the SSLC Examination during 12 years since its inception. Besides them, there are two students who appeared in Bio Chemistry and Physics degree Examinations this year. Hundreds of persons especially in the sphere of diseases have been benefitted by medical camp of the Ashramas and along with that the distributions of blankets in the relief camp during the winter season for the poor and needy persons of the localities. In all those above, Rudu-B LP School immediately needs to be upgraded upto Upper Primary Level for the benefit of the people of the area. Members and Office bearers of the R.K.
