R.K.M LP/UP/ Secondary School was established in 1971 and it managed by P.V.T (Govt of India Tribal Affairs) it is located in Rural area near Bangladesh Border. It is located in Subdivision Mawsynram Block of East Khasi Hills district of Meghalaya state. First time the school consists of grades from class (I) to class (V). Bengali is the medium of instruction in this school. That time only three Teachers and forty students in this school. The school is totally prepared by Bamboo. In this school academic session starts in March Month. The school is co - educational and it is pre - primary section. That time in this school Birendra Banai was headmaster. His hard labour this school consists of grades from Nursery to class (VII). That time the school was upgrade Primary to U.P section second time English is the medium of instruction in this school. That time only six

teachers and two hundred fifty students in this school. School academic session starts in February Month after few year later the school has building. It has got four classrooms for instructional purposes. All the classrooms are in good condition. The school has separated room for combine Headmaster and teachers. The school has no boundary wall. The school has no electric connection, the source of drinking water in the school is none. The school has no playground also no library. The school is provided midday meal but not prepared in school premises providing midday meal. In the year 2019 our new secretary Maharaj Anuragananda his own hard labour our school upgraded secondary section. Now our school has boundary wall. The school has three storey buildings now. The school has computer for teachers and learning purposes. The school is having a computer aided leading lab. Now this school has four hundred students and twelve teachers. We hope in future our school upgrades Higher Secondary School.

Short History



Our school name is Ramakrishna Mission Sec. School, Rengua. The school was founded in the years 1971 by our respected (L) Shri. Our school before it was just a small and prettiest school it has only 4 or 5 rooms with 3 or 4 and there is only L.P section. The Teachers are very good. They had maintained the school very nicely with full responsibility and nowadays our school is so big we have 15 class and one Teachers-staff and one principal room and as well Secretary Swami Anuragananda Maharaj have upgrade to Secondary section in our school Rengua. Now our school is quite okey as before we have many students as before each class has 40 plus students and also we have one Stem Lab for students practicing Science and Technology before it was not there and the Teaches are also highly qualified in our school and they are very competend and well teaching and special credit go tp our Head Teacher Mr. Binoy Banai he is the son of our respected (L) Shri. Birendro Banai without him it was not possible to established the school.

In 1971, when Ramakrishna Mission Ashrama Cherrapunjee took over the school, the head master of the school was Shri. Birendro Banai.

Ryngku and the surrounding blessed a lot by the Shree Ramakrishna Thakur and Maa Sarada Devi and also by Swami Vivekananda.

A great contribution of the Swamiji's from the monastic shrine of Cherrapunjee, East Khasi Hills District.

The local people here were proud look that faces towards the scenic beauty on the north. The local also thankful for centuries and shall remain in debted to the organization.

At first, the Ramakrishna Mission School Ryngku was L.P. section with three teachers and students



were barely sixty in numbers. The school was a small institution with limited resources and no boundaries. The class room were basic and curriculum was primary focused on foundational paved the way for change. Through community support and strategic planning, expanding our teachers and students. The school was updated and develop with four rooms of a small building. With Shri Birendra Banai's hard work both the school and students developed and the school run in this manner till 2002. In 2002, after the retirement of shri Birendra Banai, new head master was appointed, Shri Raton Roy, who served the school till August 2018.

In September 2018, new head master, Shri Binoy Banai, who was the son of late (first) Head Master of R.K.M. School Ryingku, Shri. Birendro Banai. With the efforts of **Swami Anuraganandaji Maharaj**, the school curriculum developed with the establishment of clear boundaries for the school community to ensure a safe and welcoming environment for all. The school updated till class 10 (Secondary section in 2024). The school building also developed with four storey building and increased number of student (459) and qualified teachers (14).

In this year 2024, the construction of a STEM LAB was completed. THE STEM LAB will provide hands on learning experiences in Science, technology, encouraging collaboration and creativity. This will enhance the learning experience of the students and prepare them for the challengers of the future.

Another person, Shri Bipul Banai (headman of pataghat), who is the the first son of Late Birendro Banai (first Head Master of R.K.M School Ryingku), look after the wellbeing of R.K.M School Ryingku from 2003 till date.
