The Ramakrishna Mission in Sohra (Cherrapunji) located in Meghalaya, has a rich history that reflects the mission's dedication to serving the local community.

Swami Prabhananda, who was one of the pioneering monks, initially visited Sohra in 1924. His visit highlighted the need for educational activities in the region. He faced challenges initially, as Sohra's remote location and difficult climate made establishing infrastructure.

The Ramakrishna Mission School at Umsohsun in Shillong was established by Swami Prabhananda in 1933. Swamiji received support from the local community, which valued the mission's emphasis on education.

In its early days, the school faced numerous challenges, including limited infrastructure and students. However, the dedication of Swamiji helped the school establish a foothold.

As the school gained local trust, it offered local khasi population an opportunity to learn while respecting and preserving their values-based education to young students.

Initially the school was started upto lower primary then it was upgraded to upper primary structure in 90's and now the school is offering quality education to children from diverse backgrounds, including under privileged families to Secondary section. The school actively supports students from economically weaker sections of society, providing scholarships, free education and other resources to help them succeed.

Over the years, the Ramakrishna Mission School at Umsohsun has produced many successful alumni who have gone on to contribute in various fields.

In summary, the school is more than an academic institution, it is a place where children learn values.
