History of the Ramakrishna Mission LP. School: Umthli

t was in 1965 that Ramakrishna Mission LP. School Umthli was opened Late Shri Jwan Khongstia, the Rangbah shnong with the members of the Local Executive Committee urged upon Late Babu Phelon Singh Pyngrope to help them to get a Ramakrishna Mission LP School at the village. At the request of the local Durbar with the help of the (L) Babu Philon the School was opened and Started and Started in a small hut of (L) Smt. Dina Mylliemngap with Shri Asnor Lyngdoh as the head teacher and Smt Rafina Mylliemngap the assistant teacher.

Later on the school was shifted to a school building built on the land given by the local Durbar with the right of ownership so long, the school function and continues to function. As the number of students was increasing the building was



extended twice in the year 2000 or so we got a Second building built by the office of the Block Development Officer, Pynursla Employment Assurance Scheme of the Central Government which was departmental

At present the member of students has increased very much but due to the size and condition of the classroom we cannot accommodate more than 195 Students. The problems war compounded with the inclusion of class IV and class V in the LP Section by the government without any extra rooms for them.

Today, our school is very popular. It attracts students from neighboring village also like Nongthymmai Raid. Iewmawiong and localities of Laitlyngkot like Nongthymmai, Lumthangding, Iewshyllong, Laitmawiong, Pomlum and Mawkajem. The total roll strength stand at 190.
