Khahmohi is a small village which fall under the jurisdiction of the Dorbar Shella. The school at Khahmohi was then known as Khahmohi LP School which was started in the year 2016 under the scheme SCA (BADP) and was run and manage by the village council. However, due to shortage of teachers and constraints in managing the school, the school had to close in the year 2018. The village authority appealed the Secretary, Ramakrishna Mission Ashrama, Sohra to reopen the school under the management of the Mission. It was in the year 2021 that the Mission started the Ramakrishna Mission L.P School, Khahmohi in the same infrastructure and area.

The land where **Ramakrishna Mission L.P School, Khahmohi** stands today was generously donated by the Village Authority of Khahmohi. Their selfless act of giving not only provided the physical space for the school but also set the stage for the flourishing educational institution that it is today. Since its establishment, Ramakrishna Mission L.P School, Khahmohi, has been led by dedicated head teachers who have played a pivotal role in school's development and growth. The following individuals have served as the head teachers of Ramakrishna Mission L.P School, Khahmohi, each contributing their unique leadership to shape the school into what it is today.

1) Miss Melinda Malngiang (Served from 2021 to 2024)

2) Miss Felisha Marbaniang (Present Headmistress)

Over the years, Ramakrishna Mission L.P School, Khahmohi has undergone significant upgrades to ensure that students receive a modern holistic education. Initially, Ramakrishna Mission L.P School, Khahmohi starting as a primary school with just **Nursery and K.G classes** with 56 students and the number of boys and girls is 34 and 22 respectively.

In 2022, the school upgraded to **class II** with 76 students and the number of boys and girls is 44 and 32 respectively. In 2023, saw an upgrade to **class III** with the enrollment of 89 students and the number of boys and girls is 46 and 43 respectively. In 2024, the school advanced to **class IV** with 93 students, and the number of boys and girls is 54 and 39 respectively.

The school also offered extracurricular activities like sports, drama etc., providing students with opportunities to explore their talents beyond the classroom. In addition to its educational mission, Ramakrishna Mission L.P School Khahmohi has made significant contributions to the local community. Some of these contributions include:

1) Ramakrishna Mission L.P School, Khahmohi organizes charity events, health awareness campaigns, etc. to support the local populations.
